AN is used when a noun starts with a vowel sound:

SOME is used in:

- e.g. I have got some time.
- \* questions, expressing requests and offers;

E.g. Would you like some teat

We use ANY with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns. ANY is used in:

- \* negative sentences;
- e.g. I basen't got any time.
- \* general questions;
